100% of the net proceeds from Key To The Cure will go to improving the quality of mammography services for the underserved by replacing existing analog (film) equipment with digital screening technology. Digital mammography has a number of advantages over standard film-based mammography, including lower radiation exposure to patients and higher sensitivity in detecting breast abnormalities.

Additionally, digital mammography increases patient throughput, reduces patient examination time, and leads to lower callback rates for repeat mammograms because of superior post-processing imaging capabilities acquired through the digital mammography.

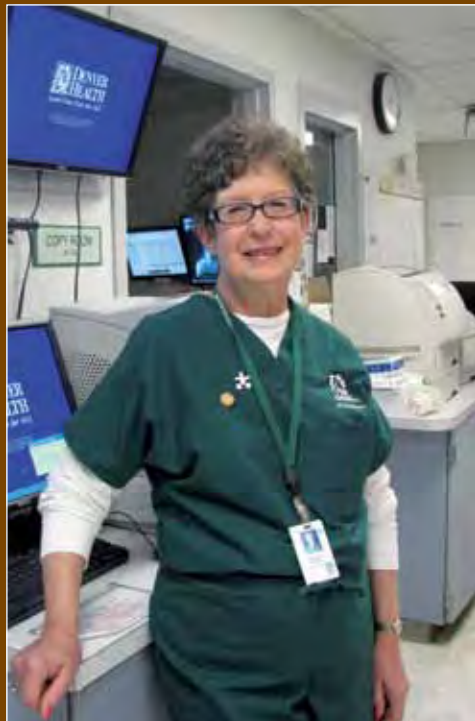

These are the words of Sara Varney, 20 year volunteer veteran to Denver Health, who unexpectedly passed away from cancer this past September. It was a true loss to Denver Health and we will miss Sara. She had a smile for everyone and helped out in the Emergency Room no matter the circumstance. Sara was known by the staff for her amazing brownies and for helping out whenever needed. She started out at the information desk of the hospital and then was promoted to the ER and then became the first Volunteer supervisor to train volunteers in the Emergency Department.

Sara was honored as Denver Health’s Volunteer of the Year and was just recently honored as Channel 7’s Everyday Hero for her exemplary work.

Her dream this past summer was to throw an extravaganza for the staff but just a month before the party, she was diagnosed with cancer. She sent the following e-mail:

“Meanwhile, do yourselves and me a favor: enjoy the gorgeous days of summer, lie on a blanket under a tree, look up at the leaves, sun, sky, clouds, and thank God every day for life.”

It would mean so much to Sara for those reading these words, to take them to heart, and to give back like she did and to value every moment and take a few moments to lie under a tree and appreciate all around you.

## The Positive Impact of Pet Therapy

**V**olunteer Services started its first Pet Therapy program at Denver Health this past summer. It began with one pet therapy team which included a Denver Health nurse volunteering her time and her Great Dane, “Blue.” Three teams of trainers and their dogs have been added, visiting at least once a week, and it has been a huge success! The dogs are trained and certified by the American Humane Organization to be in a patient care setting.

“Therapy dogs have a reputation of having a positive effect on patients who enjoy the company of animals,” said Amy Friedman, Director of Volunteer Services. “The visit often distracts the patient from the emotional and physical challenges of being in the hospital.”

Research has shown that when a patient interacts with a dog, the patient may realize reduction of blood pressure, stress, anxiety, depression and loneliness. A pet visit offers physical and emotional benefits and may help the healing process along with the patient’s well-being and staff morale. A thank you note was just received from a mother of a pediatric patient that mentioned how meaningful

it was for her little son to have been visited by “Blue” while he was recovering from being in a car accident. The other real fans of these pet visits are the staff. The staff on the units are so enthusiastic when they see the dogs arrive. We often hear “Wait! We want to visit with the dog before she goes to visit patients.”

# Level One Society: **TOAST!** to Denver's Health

**T**he Level One Society and 300 guests raised \$12,000 for the Pavilion Project at a Block Party TOAST! to Denver's Health, held September 14<sup>th</sup> next to the Governor's residence at the Boettcher Mansion. Thanks to a matching grant from the LARRK Foundation, each gift was matched dollar for dollar, and the evening raised a total of \$24,000 for the Pavilion Project. The Pavilion Project is a campaign to raise \$350,000 to Build the Right Place for Denver's Kids to Heal at the new Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Unit at Denver Health by providing special resources like computers, musical instruments, and recreation equipment. The new unit will provide a consolidated continuum of care to include 16 inpatient beds, outpatient therapy and a Substance Abuse Treatment Education and Prevention program.

Renowned Colorado photographer and preservationist John Fielder spoke publicly for the first time about his son J.T.'s struggle with depression that led to his suicide. John spoke from the heart as he shared his son's story and unveiled a breathtaking photo mural he donated that evening, to be installed in the new unit. Special guests First Lady of Colorado, Jeannie Ritter and Dr. Robert House of Denver Health spoke about the vast need for resources to offer our youth the best opportunity to heal from mental illness.

Guests enjoyed a special, live performance by Sean Kelley of The Samples. Thank you to all who attended, to our special guests, and to our event sponsors. A special thank you to John Fielder, Blue Onion, Del Norte, Governor's Park, Lala's, Alpine Waste, Oogave, Balistreri Vineyards, TOAST!
